The Green Valley Council and the Green Valley Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteers will be launching a new scam awareness campaign this fall entitled "Stop, Think, and Verify". More information to come!



Scammers rely on psychological manipulation; creating artificial panic, fear, or excitement to force you to take immediate action.

By the time you realize what happened, your money or your personal information is gone.

Break the emotional reaction cycle by introducing a forced pause: Stop, Think, and Verify before clicking, paying, engaging, or responding.

How to help:

- Legitimate officials will never demand gift cards, cash, crypto, or immediate wire transfers
- Never click the link or call the phone number in the message provided - always look up the contact information yourself
- Take a pause and ask yourself: Why is this urgent? Why do they need payment in gift cards, cash, or crypto? Did I initiate this contact? Does this sound legitimate?
- Remember, if it sounds too good to be true... it's very likely a scam

Together we can keep our community safe.

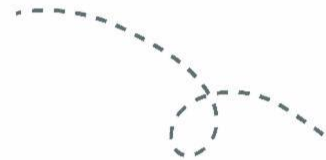
